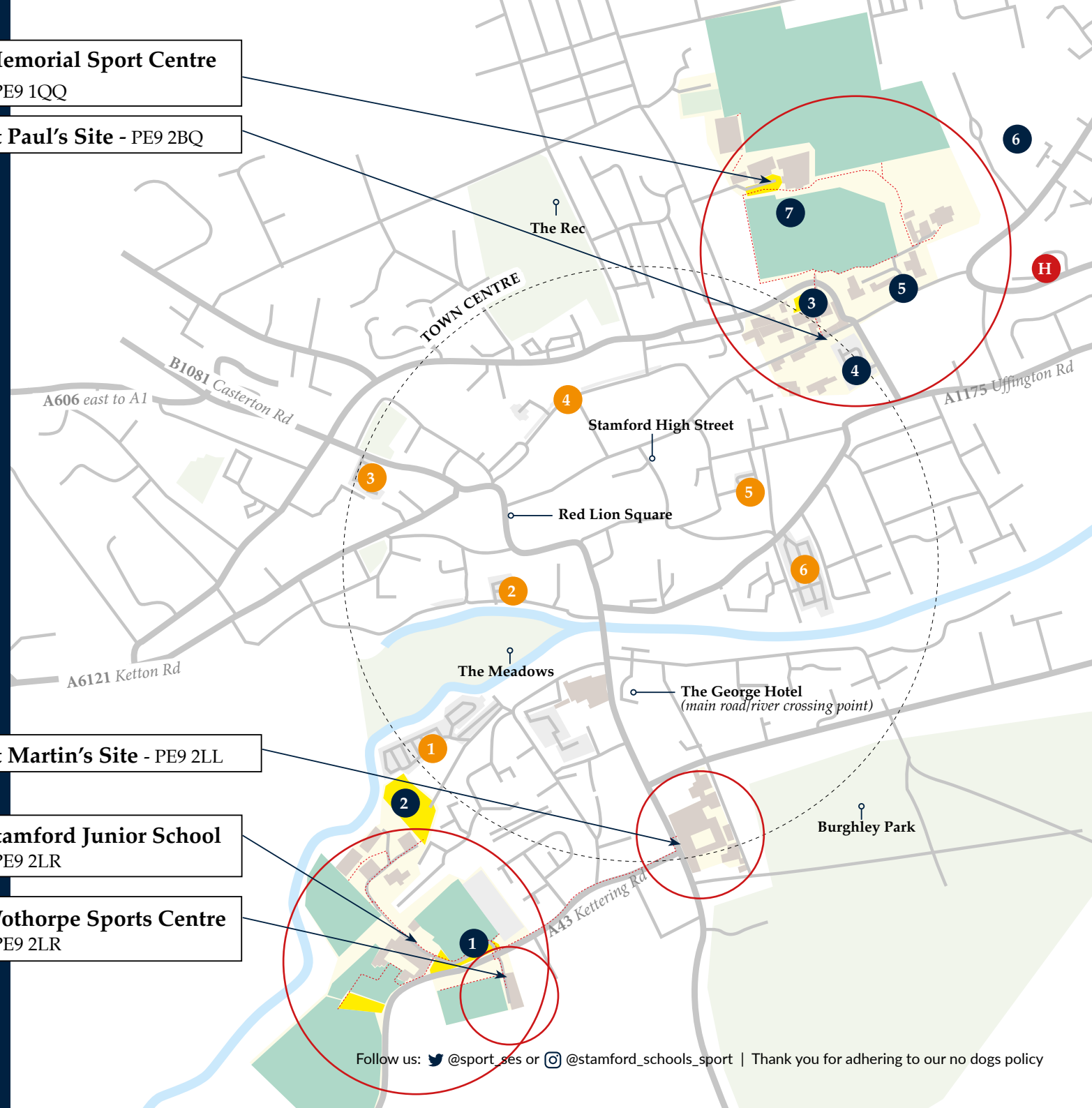

# St Paul's Site

Located to the north of Stamford town is the Senior School site, which houses our largest sports centre, swimming pool and main rugby and cricket pitches.

## Parking:

Coach parking bays are to the side of East Street. Children will be brought here for pick-up if they have not been collected from pitch side already.

Visitors are advised to park in any town centre car parks. It is a gentle uphill walk from the town centre but takes no more than 10mins to reach the sports centre. It is all wheelchair accessible, too.

Match teas are provided for students at St Paul's canteen where parents are welcome to join them for hot drinks.

Situated to the south of Stamford town centre, our Junior School has extensive grounds including the newly-opened Wothorpe Sports Centre.

  - a. Dance Studio
  - b. Circuit Studio
  - c. Fitness Suite

## Stamford Junior School Entrance/Front Office

### Parking:

Coaches need to park outside the front of St Martin's. There are coach bays either side of the road.

Children will be released out the front if they have not been picked up already from pitch side.

All visitors are advised to park in the Nursery car park. It is a short walk through the Junior School site to access Junior School facilities, Wothorpe Sport Centre and up pedestrian paths to St. Martin's.

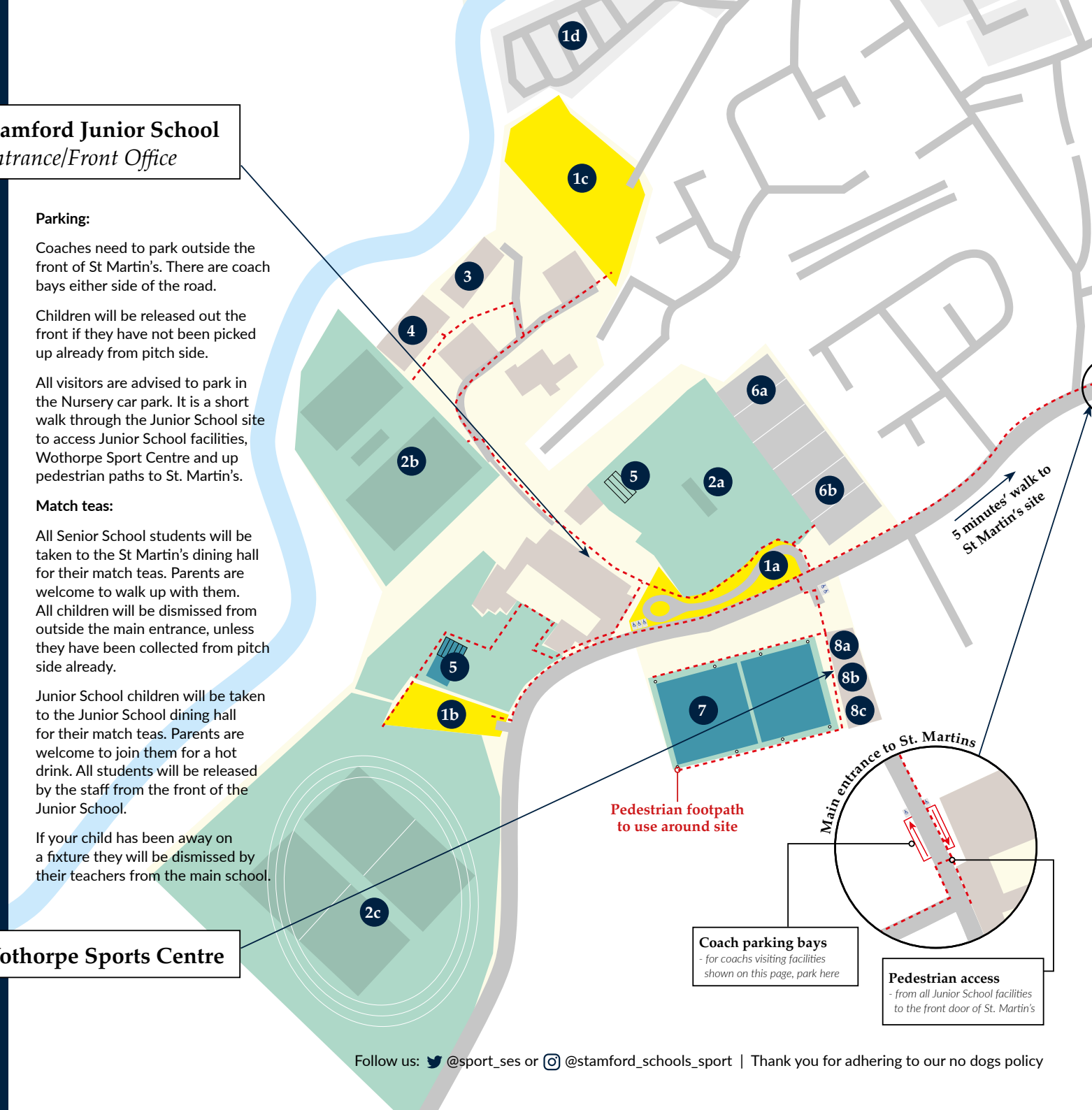
### Match teas:

All Senior School students will be taken to the St Martin's dining hall for their match teas. Parents are welcome to walk up with them. All children will be dismissed from outside the main entrance, unless they have been collected from pitch side already.

Junior School children will be taken to the Junior School dining hall for their match teas. Parents are welcome to join them for a hot drink. All students will be released by the staff from the front of the Junior School.

If your child has been away on a fixture they will be dismissed by their teachers from the main school.
